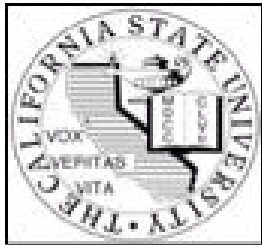

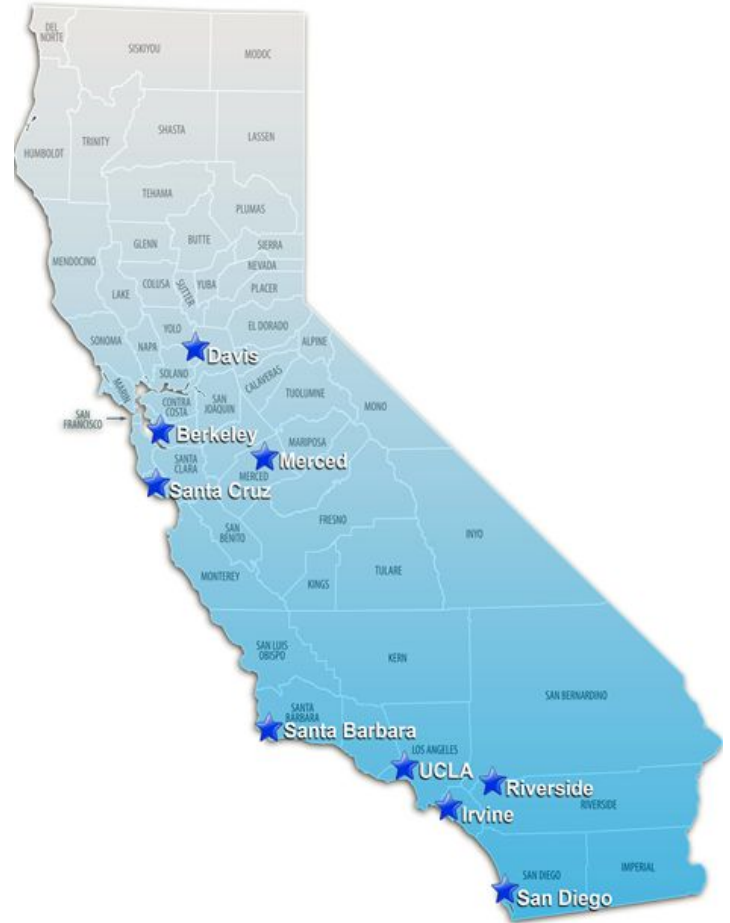

UC PERSONAL STATEMENT

8 Prompts, must respond to four. Each response is limited to max of 350 words. Make it personal!

1. Describe an example of your leadership experience in which you have positively influenced others, helped resolve disputes, or contributed to group efforts over time.
2. Every person has a creative side, and it can be expressed in many ways: problem solving, original and innovative thinking, and artistically, to name a few. Describe how you express your creative side.
3. What would you say is your greatest talent or skill? How have you developed and demonstrated that talent over time?
4. Describe how you have taken advantage of a significant educational opportunity or worked to overcome an educational barrier you have faced.
5. Describe the most significant challenge you have faced and the steps you have taken to overcome this challenge. How has this challenge affected your academic achievement?
6. Describe your favorite academic subject and explain how it has influenced you.
7. What have you done to make your school or your community a better place?
8. What is the one thing that you think sets you apart from other candidates applying to the University of California?

- About 90% of students receive financial aid
- Small class sizes
- Usually includes a specialized emphasis: Gender, Faith-Based, Ethnic Background
 - I.e. Women's Liberal Arts, HBCUs
- BEWARE of for-profit colleges

PROGRAMS TO CONSIDER



TRiO- Provides support services to students who are first generation, low-income and those in need of academic support.



Educational Opportunity Program- Assist low income and/or first generation students with their college experience.



Freshman Experience / Learning Communities II – Student Success program linking basic skills classes and counseling classes.



Puente – Provides students with English Instruction, academic counseling, and mentoring.



Honors Transfer Program – Courses and program to support students interested in an enriched academic environment and in transferring to a university.

EOP FOR CSU SYSTEM

EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY PROGRAMS

- Apply for CSU then submit EOP application - www.csumentor.org
- 2 recommendation forms for each EOP application, Ask for recommender email address now
- Every CSU campus has different EOP requirement – make sure to follow up with each EOP program
- Must apply to financial aid, FAFSA
- Complete the community college application for admission. Receive a community college student ID
- Apply for Financial Aid through FAFSA
- Complete EOPS Application, once financial aid has determined you are income eligible you will be invited to apply
